- There is no shortage of challenges for a hospital that is responding to an outbreak of hospital-acquired legionellosis (Legionnaire's Disease). The challenges of disease epidemiology, identifying and assessing patient water contacts, sampling, assessing the water system infrastructure, determining the most appropriate water treatment process and its execution, staff and public communications, and consultation with partners in Public Health, CDC, and Department of Health/CMS come in rapid fire succession and can be nearly overwhelming.
- Our seminar objectives are to take you through a recent outbreak of legionellosis and detail the steps taken with regard to epidemiology, water source investigation and sampling, water treatment selection and execution, communications, and partner consultation. The lessons learned will be shared and the continuing plan for moving forward will also be presented.
