

The role of the DMCC

Disaster Medical Coordination Center

The DMCC has one role, and one role only, during an MCI/disaster event:

Assist EMS with patient placement to the closest most appropriate facility, based on their injuries, the first time around in an attempt to prevent secondary transfers.

Regional receiving facility notification via 800 MHz

Hospital priorities prior to arrival of patients

- Initial alert for ED staff, hospital supervisors and AOC
- Rapid discharge of current ED patients
- Mobilization of OR teams, surgeons and anesthesiologists
- Request for supplies; additional staff as needed
- Set up of hospital incident command (HICS)

Lessons Learned

Communication, communication, communication....the dead zone

- DMCCs
 - Good Sam, St. Pete's & Madigan
- EMS, 911 Dispatch
 - Coordination of resources (ambulances, fire & police)
- Civilian vs. Military response
 - Adherence to regional disaster response plans
- Hospital notification
 - Multiple DMCCs activated, multiple patients per ambulance, scene chaos
- Patient distribution
 - Hospital bypass, resources available, coordination between DMCCs
